



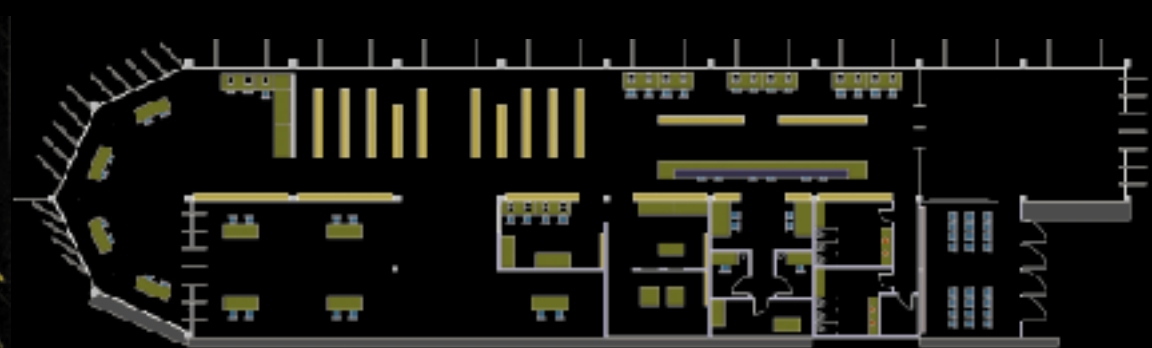
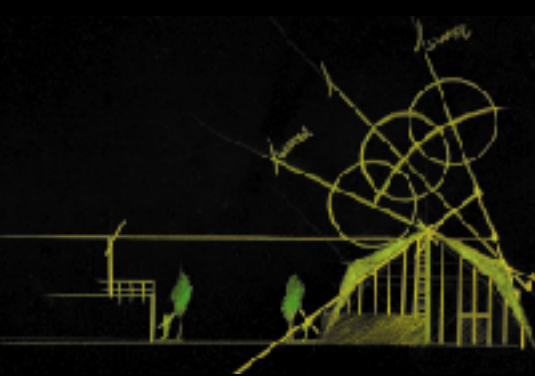
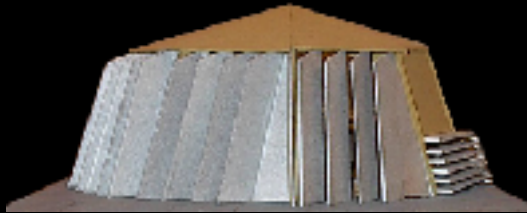
# Emeryville Public Library
